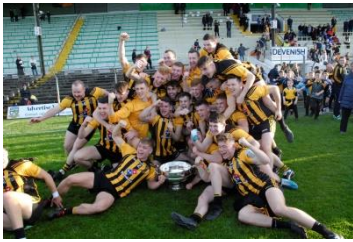

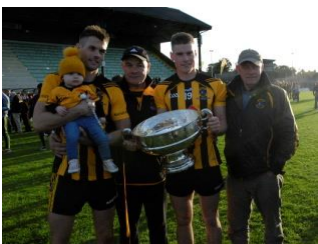


## Like Father like Son
