## Notice from Secretary of the Club

To All Members.

We would like to invite you to an EGM of the Club on **Wednesday 12th December at 8.30pm** to discuss the development of new playing facilities for the Club. The Clubs Executive has recently approved a 'Facilities Development Plan' and this is an important meeting as we seek the approval of you, the membership, to progress with these plans.

With over 1300 members, the Club currently caters for over 750 players across 60 teams in men's and ladies football, hurling and camogie. The Clubs underage section alone (up to under 18) currently facilitates the participation of over 640 children in our games. This represents growth of approximately 20% in the past 5 years.

This growth is set to continue for the coming years in line with the demographics of our community, and an increase in participation levels. The available facilities within the Club for the current level of activity is now at capacity during the core playing season (February to November) and so the development of new facilities to cater for our increasing numbers is a key priority for all of us as members.

We would greatly appreciate your attendance at this meeting given its importance.

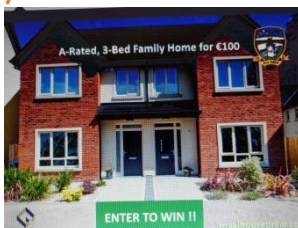
